An Act expanding the community college workforce training incentive program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 15F of chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words “not-for-credit”, each time they appear, and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following words:- “both for-credit and not-for-credit”
