An Act relative to public higher education transfers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, by December 31, 2015, all
- 2   public institutions of higher education shall permit students to transfer from one public
- 3   institution of higher education to another without loss of credit.
