In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act authorizing performance-based education funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 73 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby

2 amended by inserting, after section 12, the following new section:

3	Section 12A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law or regulation to the contrary,
4	not less than twenty-five percent of any sums appropriated by the general court for the
5	maintenance, operation and support of each state university and community college shall be
6	based on performance criteria developed by the Secretary of Education, which shall include but
7	not be limited to, the retention and successful completion of courses of study, as evidenced by
8	graduation, certification or other similar documentation, and rates or measures of the academic
9	achievement of students.
