An Act improving juror service.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 58 of chapter 234A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following sentences:- The office of jury commissioner shall provide juror service  
4 certificates to all grand and trial jurors who perform juror service. Such certificates shall be  
5 provided no later than 14 days after the last business day of each week in which a grand or trial  
6 juror performs jury service.
