Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 50 of chapter 155 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "supreme judicial or" in line 6.

3 SECTION 2. Section 50A of chapter 155 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
4 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "supreme judicial" in line 6 and
5 inserting in place thereof the word "superior".

6 SECTION 3. Section 51A of chapter 155 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
7 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "supreme judicial or" in line 3.

8 SECTION 4. Section 52 of chapter 155 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
9 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "supreme judicial or" in line 4.

10 SECTION 5. Section 50 of chapter 156 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
11 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "supreme judicial" in line 11 and
12 inserting in place thereof the word "superior".

13 SECTION 6. Section 99 of chapter 156B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
14 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "supreme judicial" in line 2 and
15 inserting in place thereof the word "superior".

16 SECTION 7. Section 103 of chapter 156B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
17 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "supreme judicial or" in lines 3 and
18 4.

19 SECTION 8. Section 104 of chapter 156B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
20 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words "supreme judicial or" in line 5.
