An Act to expand intensive parole supervision.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter twenty-seven of the general laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding after section five the following new section:-

3 Section 5A. The Parole Board shall establish in each region of the Commonwealth an  
4 intensive parole for sex offenders program. Such program shall be modeled upon the current  
5 program operated by the parole board in Middlesex County, and shall include unannounced  
6 visits, counseling, electronic monitoring, random drug testing, polygraph testing and other  
7 aspects of intensive supervision.
