An Act relative to the advisory committee on personnel standards of the Massachusetts Trial Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 52 of chapter 93 of the acts of 2011 is hereby amended by striking  
2 out the third paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

3 Section 8. There shall be an advisory committee on personnel standards. The membership  
4 of the committee shall consist of the following persons: the chief justice of the trial court or his  
5 designee; the chief justices of the trial court departments, or their designees; the court  
6 administrator or his designee, who shall serve as chair of the committee; the commissioner of  
7 probation; and three clerks of the superior court, three clerks of the district court, three registers  
8 of probate and three clerk-magistrates of the juvenile court who shall be appointed by the chief  
9 justice of the trial court.
