The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to heroin trafficking.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 32E of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as amended by chapter 192 of the acts
- 2 of 2012, is hereby amended by striking out, in subsection (c), in each instance, the figure "18"
- 3 and inserting in place thereof the following figure: "6".
- 4 And further by inserting after subsection (c), the following paragraph:-
- 5 (1) Six grams or more but less than 18 grams, be punished by a term of imprisonment in
- 6 the state prison for not less than 2 nor more than 15 years and a fine of not less than \$2,500 nor
- 7 more than \$25,000 may be imposed.
