An Act relative to workers' compensation coverage for officers of non-profit associations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1            Subsection (4) of section 1 of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the fifth paragraph the following  
3 paragraph:-

4            This chapter shall be elective for an officer of a non-profit entity or corporation, as  
5 defined by the Internal Revenue Code, who is not compensated. Notwithstanding Section 46,  
6 these provisions shall apply only if the corporate officer provides the director of industrial  
7 accidents with a written waiver of his rights under this chapter. Said director shall promulgate  
8 regulations to carry out the purpose of this paragraph. Violations of this paragraph shall subject  
9 the non-profit corporation to the penalties set forth in Section 25C.
