In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to motor vehicle homicide sentencing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 3. Section 24G of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2	official edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of subsection (c) the following
3	sentence:- Sentencing of imprisonment for the conviction of a violation of subsection (a) or (b)
4	shall be served consecutively to and not concurrent with convictions of operating a motor vehicle
5	after revocation or suspension of his or her license, and prior to the restoration of such license or
6	right to operate or the issuance to him or her of a new license or right to operate.
