**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for James DiMarino, an employee of the Sex Offender Registry Board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to
2 establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Sex Offender Registry Board,
3 therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
4 of the public health.

5 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
6 and by the authority of the same, as follows:

7 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of
8 Transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for James DiMarino, an employee of the Sex
9 Offender Registry Board. Any employee of the Sex Offender Registry Board may voluntarily
10 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by James
11 DiMarino. Whenever James DiMarino terminates employment with the department or requests to

12 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the
13 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the
14 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by
15 the department.
