In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

1 Ordered, that a Senate Special Committee to Improve Government shall be appointed for 2 the purpose of examining and evaluating performance, efficiency, service-delivery and 3 transparency across all public agencies, quasi-public entities and municipalities throughout the 4 commonwealth and matters related thereto. The committee shall seek to identify and 5 recommend measures that will result in increased savings, improved performance and enhanced 6 outcomes for the commonwealth, its political subdivisions and its citizens and may conduct other 7 activities reasonably necessary to carry out its charge. The committee may report legislation to 8 carry out its responsibilities, and the Clerk shall then refer this legislation to the committee on 9 ways and means or on rules, as the case may be. The committee may also, from time to time, 10 report other recommendations by filing them with the Clerk.
