## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to allow charter public schools to give enrollment preference to children of full-time employees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 89 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting, on line 389, after the words "shall be admitted" the following:
- 3 "Massachusetts charter public schools which operate under collective bargaining agreements
- 4 may include in contractual terms a provision to give preference in their enrollment policies to
- 5 children of full-time employees; provided, however, that said children shall not be counted
- 6 toward the charter school student cap; and provided further that said children shall not constitute
- 7 more than 5% of a school's total student population."
