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An Act relative to underground storage tank remediation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1: Subsection (d) of section 9 of Chapter 21J of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 25 and 29, the  
3 words “property damage.”.

4 SECTION 2: Section 5 of chapter 21O of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
5 Official Edition, is hereby amended in line 15 by inserting after the words “twenty-one E;” the  
6 following:-

7 provided further that such corrective action may include financial reimbursement to the  
8 owners of surrounding property who have sustained property damage due to negligent release.
