**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act authorizing the town of Boylston to convey a portion of a certain parcel of land.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The town of Boylston may sell a portion of the property known as “Hillside”, located
2 along Main street, and acquired by the town by an order of taking dated April 14, 1997, recorded
3 at the Worcester district registry of deeds in book 18761, page 25. The portion of land to be sold
4 is located along the westerly sideline of Elmwood place, contains approximately 178,321 square
5 feet of land and is shown on a sketch plan entitled “Plan of Land for Sale, Elmwood Place,
6 Boylston, MA” dated March 7, 2016, prepared by James P. Smith, and available for public
7 inspection during regular business hours at the office of the town clerk.
