An Act prohibiting the use of all latex gloves and products by persons who handle food.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section  
2 305E the following section:

3           Sec 305F. Any person engaged in wholly or in part in the production, manufacturing,  
4 processing, storing and/or offering or exposing any article of food for consumption, and whose  
5 duties and activities involve handling and contact with food at any stage during the process, shall  
6 not use natural latex rubber gloves or utensils containing natural rubber latex.

7           If the Department of Health finds, after notice and due opportunity for hearing, that any  
8 establishment, group or vendor is not in compliance with the provisions of this section, it may  
9 assess civil penalties in an amount not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500), and may be subject

- 10 to any and all penalties provided for in General Laws which regulate said industry, including
- 11 revocation of licenses.
