The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to fire safety of state-owned buildings, structures and property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 148 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 4 the following section:-
- 3 Section 4A. Applicability of the fire laws and fire code in state-owned buildings. The
- 4 provisions of the state fire code under this chapter, and the rules and regulations promulgated
- 5 therefrom by the board of fire prevention regulations, shall apply to all buildings, structures and
- 6 property owned, operated or controlled by the commonwealth, other than the State House. The
- 7 head of the fire department, as defined in section 1, shall enforce the provisions of this chapter
- 8 and section with respect to all buildings, structures and property owned, operated or controlled
- 9 by the commonwealth located within such city, town or district.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
