The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to non-resident firearm licensing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 131F of Chapter 140 of the General Law is hereby amended by inserting a new
2 paragraph:-

3 Any person who was previously a resident of the Commonwealth and held a License to
4 Carry Firearms in good standing under section 131 that:

5 1. Currently owns property that is utilized by them as a personal residence for a
6 minimum of thirty days in a calendar year, or

7 2. Currently maintains a vehicle registered in the Commonwealth, or

8 3. Currently attends school in the Commonwealth, or

9 4. Currently owns a business within the Commonwealth

10 Shall be entitled to apply for a license to carry firearms under section 131.
