In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to digital projectors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 83 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the owner, user or exhibitor
- 4 of a cinematograph or motion picture machine operated with a digital projection system shall not
- 5 be required to maintain a fire extinguisher in the booth or enclosure in which the digital
- 6 projection system is kept or used.
