An Act relative to collective bargaining.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no funds of the
- 2 Commonwealth shall be expended for non-employee attorney service or management consultants
- 3 for services performed for collective bargaining or issues arising from collective bargaining
- 4 contracts.
