## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to certain option B and option C retirees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the 2 contrary, a member, who retired before July 1, 2004 and is receiving a lesser retirement 3 allowance in accordance with the terms of Options (b) or (c) of subdivision (2) of section 12 of 4 chapter 32 of the General Laws, from a retirement system that accepts the provisions of this act, 5 shall have his retirement allowance, exclusive of any cost of living adjustments, increased by 12 6 per cent. Any retirement system may accept the provisions of this act by a majority vote of the 7 board of each such system, subject to the approval of the legislative body. For the purposes of 8 this act, "legislative body" shall mean, in the case of a city, the city council in accordance with 9 its charter, in the case of a town, the board of selectmen, in the case of a county, the county 10 retirement board advisory council, in the case of a region, the regional retirement board advisory 11 council, in the case of a district, the district members, and, in the case of an authority, the

- governing body. For purposes of this act, the state teachers' and state employees' retirement systems shall be deemed to have accepted the provisions of this act.
- SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall be prospective from the effective date of this act and shall not entitle any member or spouse of a deceased member to any retroactive benefits.
