An Act requiring review for determining category 4 eligibility.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 5 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word “payments”, in line 231, the following words:- ;  
3 provided, however, that notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection, said commission shall  
4 review a superannuation application for any applicant who is a member of Group 4, or has held a  
5 Group 4 position and whose last regular compensation derived from employment as a secretary  
6 of an executive office as defined in section 2 of chapter 6A and in its discretion may deny  
7 superannuation at Group 4 for the period of employment of such secretary notwithstanding  
8 section 10 or any other section of this chapter to the contrary.
