An Act exempting the County of Norfolk from the Massachusetts earned sick time law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the County of Norfolk and
- 2   political subdivisions shall be exempt from the Massachusetts Earned Sick Time Law M.G.L.
- 3   c.149, S. 148c and the accompanying regulations, 940 CMR 33.00.
