An Act relative to state pensions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Acts of 2009 Ch 21 sec 20 is hereby amended to add the following sentence: “No person
2 retired from the Commonwealth who was employed by a regional transit authority on or before
3 July 1, 2009 shall be subject to employment and earnings restrictions in Ch. 32 sec. 91. Any such
4 person who waived their pension per Ch. 32 sec. 90B shall have their pension restored effective
5 on the date of the waiver.
