An Act relative to Massachusetts certified emergency telecommunicators.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Amend Part I, Title IV, Chapter 32, Section 3, paragraph G, “Group 2” of the
- 2 Massachusetts General Laws by inserting the following after the words “Cushing hospital”:
- 3 All Full Time Dispatchers, Dispatch Supervisors, Communications Center Directors or
- 4 Communications Chiefs certified by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts State 911 Department
- 5 as Certified Telecommunicators as defined by MA 560 CMR 5.04
