**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act to ensure fairness through the economic development tax increment financing program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 40, Section 59, paragraph (iii)(b) is hereby amended by removing
2 the following: “provided, however, that the ratio shall not be less than 1;”.
