An Act exempting public school stadiums from certain state regulations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section  
2 13, the following new section:-

3           Section 13A. For the purposes of preventing unnecessary additional expenses to  
4 municipalities and school districts, public school athletic stadiums for the use of K-12  
5 populations are exempt from Uniform State Plumbing Code 248 CMR 10.10:18.
