- 1 Section 3 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by striking out the words “seven hundred dollars”, in lines 195, 218 and 240,
- 3 and inserting in place thereof, in each instance, the figure:— \$1,500.
