Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2H of chapter 29 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
- 2 chapter 165 of the acts of 2014, is hereby further amended by inserting, in the first paragraph,
- 3 after "affecting state revenues" the following:--
