An Act relative to charges associated with condominiums in tax title.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 77 of Chapter 60 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence at the end of the first  
3 paragraph:

4           A city or town shall not be deemed to receive any benefit from such provisions, prior to  
5 foreclosure of its tax title, unless it occupies or collects rent from such property.
