**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act establishing a 1-year waiting period for new taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 58 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 52. No new tax shall be collected, assessed or payable until 1 year after the
- 3 passage of the act in which the new tax was created.
