**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act promoting transparency in public bidding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (b) of clause (1) of section 44D of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 The applicant shall provide, under the penalties of perjury, truthful and complete
4 information in all bids or offers. Whoever violates any provision of this paragraph shall be
5 punished by imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by a fine of not more than \$50,000 or
6 by such fine and imprisonment.
