An Act relative to municipal lease negotiations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the legislative body of the  
2 town of Dedham may discuss lease negotiations with the Department of Capital and Asset  
3 Management and Maintenance for a period of 10 years. Such discussions shall be conducted on  
4 behalf of the Norfolk County District Attorney’s Office for the purpose of relocating said District  
5 Attorney’s Office within the Town of Dedham.
