**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act establishing school bus driver day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting after Section 15TTTTT, the following section:-

3 Section 15UUUUU. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart
4 October 20 as School Bus Drivers’ Day, in recognition of the invaluable contributions of the
5 Commonwealth’s school bus drivers to the safe delivery of the state’s children to and from
6 school, through all forms of climates and conditions, twice a day for 180 days a year, and shall
7 recommend that the day be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
