Humason, Jr., that the commissioner of the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance be authorized to transfer a certain parcel of land in the city of Westfield to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for construction purposes. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act providing for transfers of land in Westfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2	Commissioner of the Division of Capital Asset Management and maintenance, in consultation
3	with the Chief Medical Examiner and the Commissioner of the Department Of Public Health,
4	may transfer to the Chief Medical Examiner a parcel of land and improvements thereon and
5	easements appurtenant thereto in the city of Westfield to the office of the chief medical examiner
6	for the construction of a regional facility for the use of the Chief Medical Examiner. The parcel
7	is currently in the care and control of the Department of Public Health and is located on the
8	westerly side of East Mountain Road north of the Western Massachusetts hospital. The parcel
9	contains approximately 7.7 acres of land and is improved with a storage building having an

address of 240 East Mountain Road. The exact boundaries of the parcel and any appurtenant
easements shall be determined by the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance
based on a final survey. The transfer agreement may provide that the existing storage building
and other buildings on the parcel may continue to be used by the Department of Public Health
until they are no longer needed by said department.

15 SECTION 2. Upon construction of the regional facility referenced in section 1, the 16 Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance may assume the control and supervision 17 of the management, repair, and maintenance operations of the facility and other improvements to 18 the extent agreed upon between the Commissioner and the Chief Medical Examiner, with the 19 approval of the Secretary of Administration and Finance. Upon approval of any such agreement, 20 the Secretary of Administration and Finance shall forthwith file a written notice with the 21 Comptroller and the House and Senate Committees on Ways and Means, specifying the scope of 22 the authority so granted to the Division and the duration thereof. Where the Commissioner has 23 assumed such control and supervision, the Commissioner shall make quarterly reports to the Secretary of Administration and Finance on the status of such maintenance, management and 24 25 repair operations so assumed.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Commissioner of the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance, in consultation with the Commissioner of the Department of Youth Services and the Commissioner of the Department of Public Health, may transfer from the Department of Public Health to the Department of Youth Services a parcel of land for the use of the Department of Youth Services. The parcel is located on the easterly side of East Mountain Road at the intersection of Springfield road in the City of Westfield. Said parcel consists of approximately 3.6± acres of land and is

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improved with the facility known as the Hampden County Secure Detention Facility which is
being used by the Department of Youth Services. The boundaries of said parcel shall be
determined by the Commissioner of the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance
based on a survey.

37 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the 38 Commissioner of the Division Of Capital Asset Management And Maintenance, in consultation 39 with the Commissioner of the Department Of Youth Services and the Commissioner of the 40 Department Of Public Health, may transfer from the Department Of Youth Services to the 41 Department Of Public Health an unimproved parcel of land in the City of Westfield consisting 42 of approximately $3.0\pm$ acres adjacent to the easterly boundary of the parcel described in section 3 43 and adjacent to the southerly side of property of the Western Massachusetts hospital. The parcel 44 shall be used for public health purposes. The boundaries of said parcel shall be determined by 45 the Commissioner of the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance based on a 46 survey.
