An Act relative to energy efficiency.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph 2 of subsection (b) of section 21 of chapter 25 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after clause (I) the following clause:-
3 ; and (J) programs that result in customers switching to a different heating fuel, provided
4 that the program increases efficiency;
