An Act regulating of pipelines.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 164 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the  
2 following section:-

3           Section 75I. Any natural gas that travels though transmission line piping though a  
4 transmission gas line in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts must be used in, and only in, the  
5 Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
