In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to double poles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 34B of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "pole;" in line 5, the following:
- 3 "provided further, that a city or town may enforce this section by the enactment of a local
- 4 ordinance or bylaw prohibiting double poles beyond the ninety days authorized by this section,
- 5 violation of which may be punishable by a fine not to exceed a maximum two hundred dollars
- 6 per occurrence, per day."
