An Act to expand membership opportunities in local cultural councils.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 58 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws be amended by striking out the  
2 second sentence in the fourth paragraph and inserting the following: -"The chief appointing  
3 authority and members of the local appropriating authority, as defined in M.G.L. Chapter 59,  
4 Section 21C, cannot serve as council members."
