**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act repealing Chapter 32, Section 90(G) ³/₄.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition is
2 hereby amended by repealing Section 90G ³/₄.

3 SECTION 2. Any member who made an election under G.L. c. 32, s. 90G ³/₄ prior to the
4 effective date of this act shall have said election maintained after the repeal of said section and
5 no further action need be taken by the member or retirement board.
