An Act relative to low digit number plates on leased vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 6C the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 6D. Upon the expiration or termination of a lease for a private passenger vehicle,  
4 a lessee may reassign a low digit number plate, also referred to as a passenger reserved or lottery  
5 plate, to a newly leased private passenger vehicle without physically presenting the plate or  
6 otherwise appearing before the registrar. The lessor of the newly leased vehicle shall complete  
7 and file any documents required by the registrar to effect the reassignment on behalf of the  
8 lessee.

9 The registrar shall promulgate any rules and regulations necessary to carry out this  
10 section.
