An Act relative to license plates for disabled veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The eighth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 232 to 233, the words “a  
3 pleasure passenger vehicle or pick-up truck” and inserting in place thereof the following words:-  
4 no more than 2 pleasure passenger vehicles or pick-up trucks.
