An Act relative to updating Massachusetts driver education.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 13D of Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 22, by striking the words “Motorcycle Safety  
3   Foundation” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- “Massachusetts Motorcycle  
4   Rider Education Program”.

5           SECTION 2. Section 32G of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
6   Official Edition, is hereby amended, in lines 190-191, by striking the words “Motorcycle Safety  
7   Foundation” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- “Massachusetts Motorcycle  
8   Rider Education Program”.
