**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to Chapter 32, Section 15(7) determinations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subdivision 7 of section 15 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended in line 74 by striking the phrase: “as determined by the commission”.

3 SECTION 2. Said subdivision is further amended by inserting the following at the end of
4 the paragraph:

5 The board shall notify the commission of any proceedings commenced pursuant to this
6 section and shall provide any and all documents relating to said proceedings upon request of the
7 commission. Notwithstanding the waiver provisions of Paragraph (a) of Subdivision 3 of section
8 21 of chapter 32 of the General Laws any calculations performed pursuant to this section will be
9 submitted to the commission for approval.
