**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to the Community Preservation Trust Fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 55 of Chapter 23K of the General Laws be amended by striking out,
2 in subsection (c), the phrase “9 per cent” and replacing it with the following :- “4.5 per cent”

3 SECTION 2. Section 55 of Chapter 23k of the General Laws be amended by adding, at
4 the end of subsection (c), after the phrase “section 60” the following: - “and 4.5 percent of its
5 daily gross gaming revenue to the Community Preservation Trust Fund.
