Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 92A½ of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 14 the following section:-
- 3 Section 14A. The commissioner shall establish the Sudbury watershed advisory
- 4 committee. The purpose of the committee shall be to advise the division on its policies and
- 5 regulations regarding fishing, boating and other recreational activities as well as environmental
- 6 affairs, wildlife and habitat matters, and sustainable wildlife programs, within the watershed. The
- 7 commissioner of the department shall appoint to the advisory committee 1 person from 3 names
- 8 nominated by each of the following organizations: the Massachusetts Council of Sportsmen,
- 9 Trout Unlimited, a representative of a rod and gun club located in the town of Ashland,
- 10 Framingham, Hopkinton, Marlborough, Northborough, Southborough, and Westborough, a
- designee of the board of selectmen of each of the towns of Ashland, Framingham, Hopkinton,
- 12 Northborough, Southborough, and Westborough and a designee of the city councilors in the city

of Marlborough, a representative of the Massachusetts Audubon Society, a representative of the Sudbury Valley Trustees, a representative of the Massachusetts Outdoor Heritage Foundation and 1 member from the general public.

The committee shall elect a chairperson from among its members, shall meet at least twice each calendar year, and may provide for alternate members to participate fully in its meetings whenever a regular member is unable to do so.
