Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of Section 20 of chapter 40B of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 9 after the word
- 3 "organization.", the words: "Low and moderate income housing shall also include mobile
- 4 homes and group homes, manufactured homes, in-law apartments and any first-time home
- 5 buyers participating in any state or federal assistance program.".
