**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to pre-trial detention.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 35 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 8, the word thirty and inserting in
3 place thereof the following word: -twenty.
