An Act clarifying the rights of employees in education collaboratives.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 4E of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following sentence after the first sentence in the ninth  
3 paragraph:-

4           The provisions of sections forty-one, forty-two, forty-two D and forty-three of chapter 71  
5 shall apply to each category of employees named in those sections who serve in education  
6 collaboratives.
