In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to annoying telephone calls.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after

2 section 14B the following section:-

3	Section 14C. Whoever allows his telephone to be used by another to telephone a person
4	or his family, repeatedly, for the sole purpose of harassing, annoying or molesting that other
5	person or his family or for the purpose of repeatedly using indecent or obscene language to that
6	person or his family, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for
7	not more than 3 months, or both.
